The "Find an Organizer" option narrows your search by geography and by the area that needs organizing (such as residential, closet design, office, and relocation.) Organizers specializing in clients diagnosed with Attention Deficit Disorder, hoarders and those who have other special needs can also be found.

"We are expected to accomplish more each day, often with fewer resources. If clutter is adding to your stress level, professional organizers can develop simple, organized systems and remove the word 'overwhelmed' from your vocabulary," states Chris McKenry, NAPO-LA president. "Our members are able to access your needs and teach the organizing principles needed to make life more productive."

The site features a video showcasing the work of professional organizers. In January, during "Get Organized" Month, 20 volunteers from NAPO-LA organized the local offices of the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW/LA). NCJW/LA is a non-sectarian, non-profit organization that provides life-changing services to women and children.
